- An advanced search tool allowing users to locate projects, project partners, methods and results.

## Why SocialDialogue.net?

**Employment policy** is recognised as one of the cornerstones of European economic and social development.

The **European Employment Strategy**, aims to support sustainable economic growth, with more and better jobs for everyone and greater social cohesion. European society needs to adapt not only to the demands of the global, knowledge based economy - but also, in a way that ensures that all its citizens, including disabled people, are able to play a role in the job market.
